Roller Ballet was originally made as part of 'Heelz on Wheelz', a performance and visual art production by Fittings Multimedia. Described as 'a subversive journey through sex, beauty and alternative lifestyles', this touring production featured a range of fantasy footwear that brought together nice and nasty, clean and dirty.

Roller Ballet offers the viewer a juxtaposition of opposing themes. Classical combining with the street, it's a marriage of point shoe in blood red, with ribbon lacing, and low-tech early roller skate wheels. The piece is displayed in action on a half pipe high stand. The ribbons are wired to flow out behind. Shoe donated by The Royal Ballet.
